This tour takes a bold approach to the brick-clad Ville Rose. Some of the gems of its heritage **have been internationally acknowledged by UNESCO**, such as the Basilica of St Sernin, on the pilgrimage route to Santiago de Compostela, and the Canal du Midi. We'll let you in on all these secrets as we take you from the Place du Capitole to the banks of the Garonne, via the Gothic exterior of the Jacobins Convent.

At a glance, you'll discover a mosaic of brickwork, 19th-century buildings and their cast-iron lacework, the massive structure of a Southern-style church and a **180° panoramic view of a river** that's not as peaceful as it looks!

Of course, we can't show you everything — Toulouse deserves more of your time! That's the charm of this tour: in just a few minutes, we'll introduce you to the city, but more importantly to its personality!
