## MORNING

Start your day with a ride on the little tourist train!

An original and ideal way to discover the historic heart of Toulouse. Your tour begins at Place du Capitole, then continues to Saint-Sernin Basilica. You'll admire beautiful views over the Canal de Brienne, La Grave Chapel, and the Pont Neuf. Finally, you'll pass by the courtyard of the Hôtel d'Assézat and the charming streets of the Saint-Étienne district. The train brings you back to Place du Capitole.

Our guide will meet your group at the end of the tour.

Now it's time for a gourmet experience!

Follow a route **through a Toulouse market**. When heritage meets local gastronomy, both your eyes and your taste buds are in for a treat.

During this walk, you'll admire the architectural heritage and trace its evolution: a bell on the façade of the iconic Capitole, a grocery shop that has become a local institution in a charming street, stories of porters and mules... The routes all lead to the most beautiful covered markets: Victor Hugo or Les Carmes.

There, the second part of the adventure begins: **meeting local food artisans**—cheesemongers, caterers, and pastry chefs—who will delight your senses with irresistible tastings!



## LUNCH

On a terrace, in a cellar, above the market, or in a lively neighborhood, discover **our selection of great addresses in Toulouse!**

## AFTERNOON

Discover one of Toulouse's emblems: the violet. Introduced to France under Napoleon III, it has become one of the city's symbols. Since 1985, the name "**Violette de Toulouse**" has been a registered trademark.

Since 1993, La Maison de la Violette has developed around a hundred products inspired by the flower and is actively involved in preserving and promoting this unique regional heritage.
