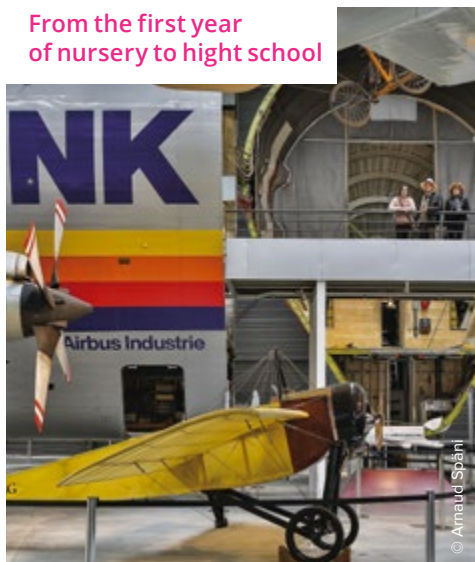

THE FLIGHT OF THE PIONEERS

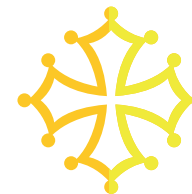
